Volunteer Opportunities: Volunteer at AAR and help with Dog walking, Dog Care, Cat Care, Basic Animal Grooming (baths).

Note: Home Animal Fostering is not an approved Legacy service activity for receiving hours.

When: Shifts are 8-10am and 3-5pm daily for dogs; 8-10am and 2-4pm for cats

Age restriction: Legacy's 13-15 yr. old volunteers must be accompanied by a Mom/parent. Age 13 can volunteer only with cats. Ages 14-15 may volunteer with cats and limited opportunities with dogs. Legacy members 16 yrs. and older may volunteer without a Mom/parent.

Volunteer Scheduling and Communication:

Go to www.aartexas.org, click on "get Involved," then select "volunteer", and follow the instructions to apply to volunteer. In the application form, pick an area in which you wish to be trained, then you will be contacted by the volunteer coordinator to set up a training session.

Important Summer Volunteering information/training for 14-15 yr olds (with parent) - Play Yard Friend (PYF) summer opportunities ONLY will be during the week of June 5-11th. **All interested (both parent and teen) will need to be registered on our website to volunteer then sign up on the schedule once registered.** There are 8 spots (4 parent/teen teams) per day of training.

At the time of training you will be asked to commit to at least (3) 2 hour dog care shifts over the entire summer -- you CAN sign up for more online-- but at least 3 at time of training. (so bring your calendars with you to training)

- Therefore 14-15 yr olds should go online and register to volunteer first (according to the instructions on the attached info sheet) and then you will be able to sign up for training for the PYF opportunities before they fill up.
- 14-15 year olds may sign up for cattery care training at any time
- 16+ may sign up for dog or cat care training at any time

Dress Code:

- Closed toe shoes are a MUST. Volunteers may even want to wear rain boots because one of tasks could be washing dogs and the dog runs.
- Volunteers are encouraged to wear old jeans, capris or mid-length shorts. The cute dogs and puppies love to play and that means jumping on the volunteers.
- DO NOT wear your Legacy purple polo, it will get ruined. Volunteers are to wear old T-shirts (but no V-necks).
- Volunteers are NOT allowed to wear tank tops, short shorts, blue jean shorts, yoga pants or open toe shoes.
